

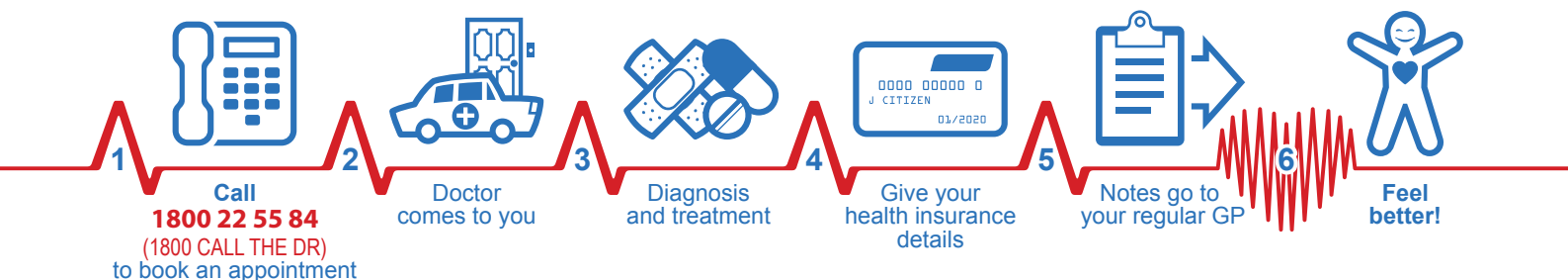
CALL THE DOCTOR

Need after-hours care when your campus doctor is not available?

If you're visiting Tasmania as an international student, you should know about the healthcare services available after-hours, when regular GPs and on-campus clinics are closed.

In most cases it's FREE to you, and the cost of the doctor can be claimed from your insurer. Here's how the service works:

1. Call **1800 22 55 84**
2. An after-hours doctor will come to your home or on-campus accommodation
3. Take the medication that the doctor prescribes, or follow the treatment plan they give you
4. Provide your health insurance details
5. Detailed notes from your after-hours consultation will be sent to your regular GP or on-campus healthcare provider
6. Get better and keep on studying



Will I have to pay?

No, it's FREE to you in most cases!

If you have **OSHC** cover from
another insurance provider

You will need to pay an after-hours consulting fee. Many OSHC providers let you claim some of this fee back, but the out-of-pocket cost is different for each insurer.

If you do not have OSHC
you will have to pay the full after-hours consulting fee
